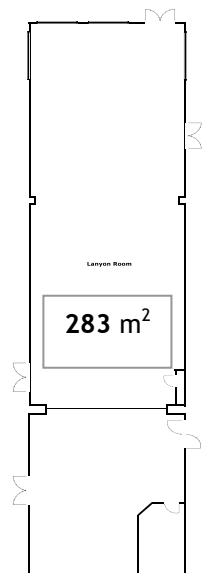

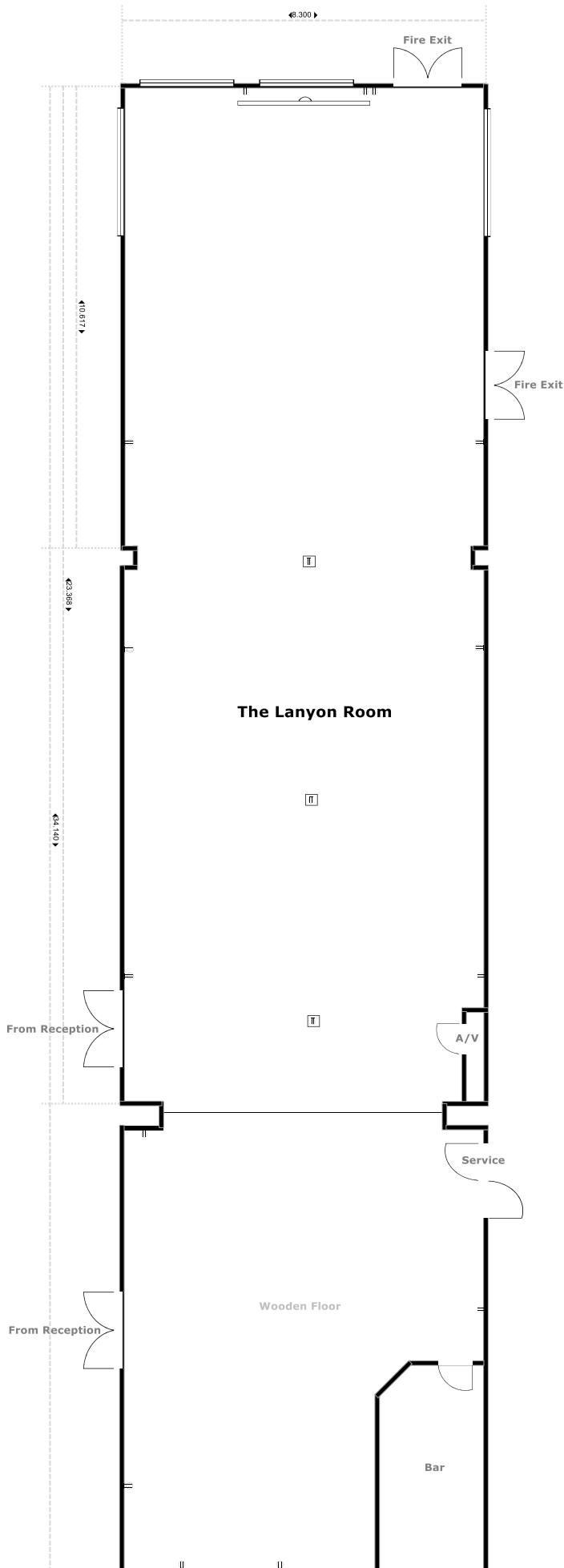


Room Location: Ground Floor, off Hotel Reception
